Consider these statistics:

- Chronic kidney disease (CKD) is more common among women than men and is the eighth-leading cause of death worldwide. Nine out of ten people with Stage 3 CKD (moderately decreased kidney function) do not know they have it. Early detection can help prevent the progression of kidney disease to kidney failure and other health complications.²
- Women who have had gestational diabetes have a 35–60% chance of developing diabetes in the next 10–20 years.³
- Without proper diagnosis and access to healthcare, women are at twice the risk of premature death leading from the common complications of diabetes: cardiovascular disease, stroke, and kidney failure.⁴



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
