What is Multi-Factor Authentication?

 Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) is required **to get access** to applications containing **confidential data**.

First factor for User Authentication

Something you KNOW



The first factor is always your **personal password**.

Second factor for User Authentication

Something you HAVE



For the second factor authentication, there are **several options** available explained here: Authenticate yourself



- via an authenticator app on your mobile device*
- via phone SMS message
- via HW token



*We recommend you setting up MFA with the Microsoft Authentication app. On the following slides it is explained how you can do this.

General information

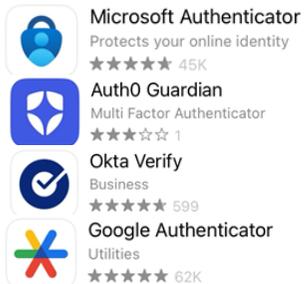
Multi-factor authentication (MFA) provides an additional level of user authentication security. Some applications can be accessed with a single-factor authentication, typically username/email and password, some applications require any kind of 2nd-factor in addition to the single-factor authentication method. When using the term “multi-factor authentication” or MFA, this typically means that an application requires multiple authentication steps to grant the user access.

In terms of Healthineers-ID for customer-facing applications an user must 1st enter email address with the corresponding password and 2nd enter the one-time password from the MFA authenticator app of choice.

Preparations

Healthineers-ID MFA requires an authenticator app of your choice. Basically, any authenticator app like Microsoft Authenticator app, Google Authenticator, Auth0 Guardian or Okta Verify are supported, but this tutorial used Microsoft Authenticator for the screenshots.

Make sure you have Microsoft Authenticator or any alternative authenticator app installed on your mobile device.



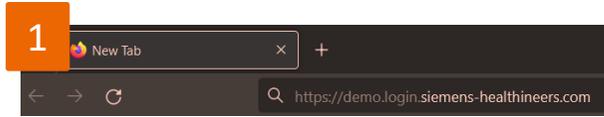
Microsoft Authenticator or an alternative authenticator apps can be downloaded from the Public App Stores. Please navigate to your preferred App Store and install the app.

Step-by-step instruction

This guide show screens from the common use cases, but still may vary slightly to the actual screens, depending on the client location (trusted network or internet) and the current MFA profile configuration of the Healthineers-ID account.

MFA is initiated automatically, if the accessing application requires additional protection. In this documentation we assume that MFA is required and the MFA process was initiated automatically. To immediately start the MFA process, you can also use the Healthineers-ID Login Demo app (described separately).

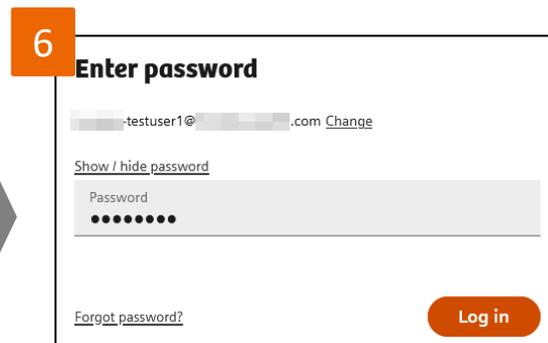
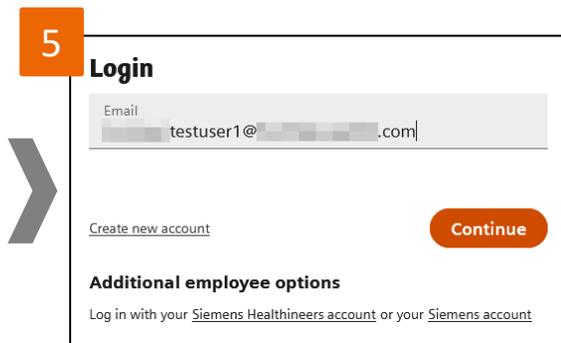
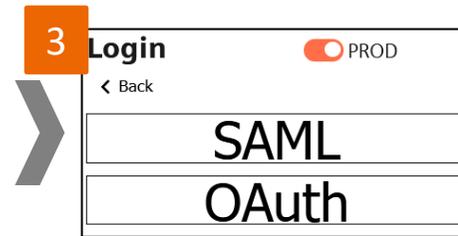
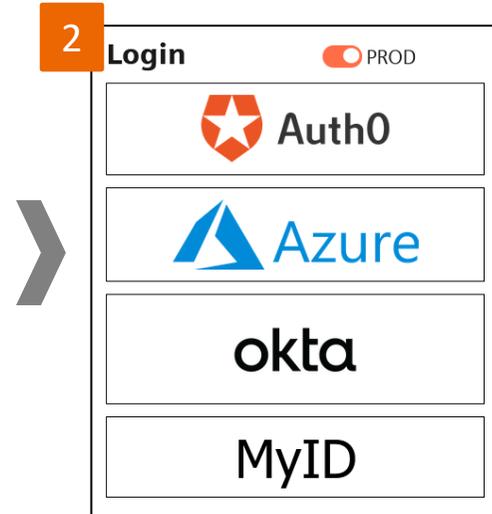

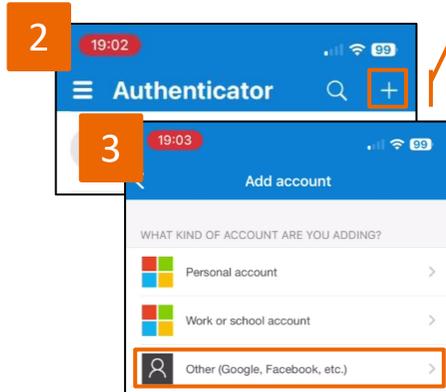
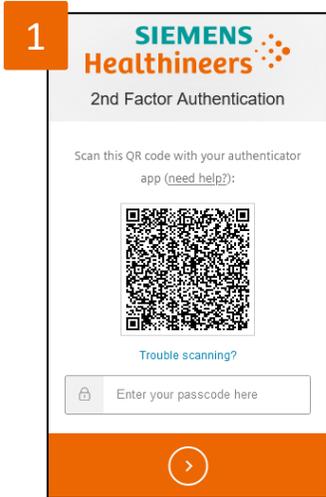
1. Enter the URL of the Healthineers Login Demo app
<https://demo.login.siemens-healthineers.com> in your browser
2. Click the "Auth0" button
3. Click the "OAuth" button
4. Click the "MFA" button



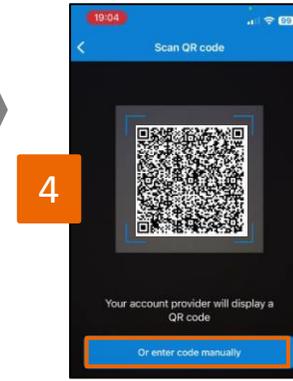
5. Enter your Healthineers-ID username, which is the email address of your account.
6. Enter the password of your Healthineers-ID account.

Healthineers-ID MFA enrollment

1. If MFA is not enrolled for your account yet, you will see this QR code in your browser to start the MFA enrollment.



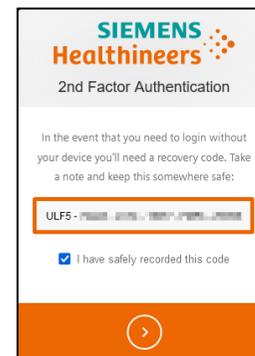
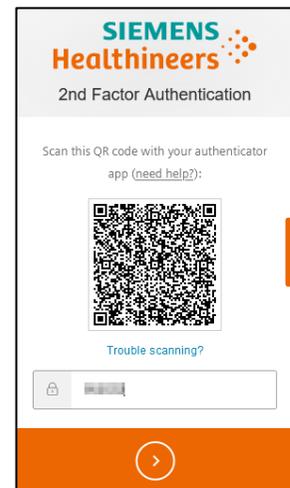
2. Open the Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile device and click the + to start the enrollment on your mobile device.
3. Select "Other (Google, Facebook, etc.)" to continue.
4. With your authenticator app on your mobile device **scan the code** from the browser.



i Press "Or enter code manually" if you are unable to scan the code from the browser yet.



5. Your new MFA profile is now shown in the authenticator app of your mobile device, but **still needs a final step to complete**.
6. Enter the current code from the authenticator app in the field "Enter your passcode here" of the browser.



i Store this code safely. This code allows you to sign-in in case your authenticator app is not working or currently not available.

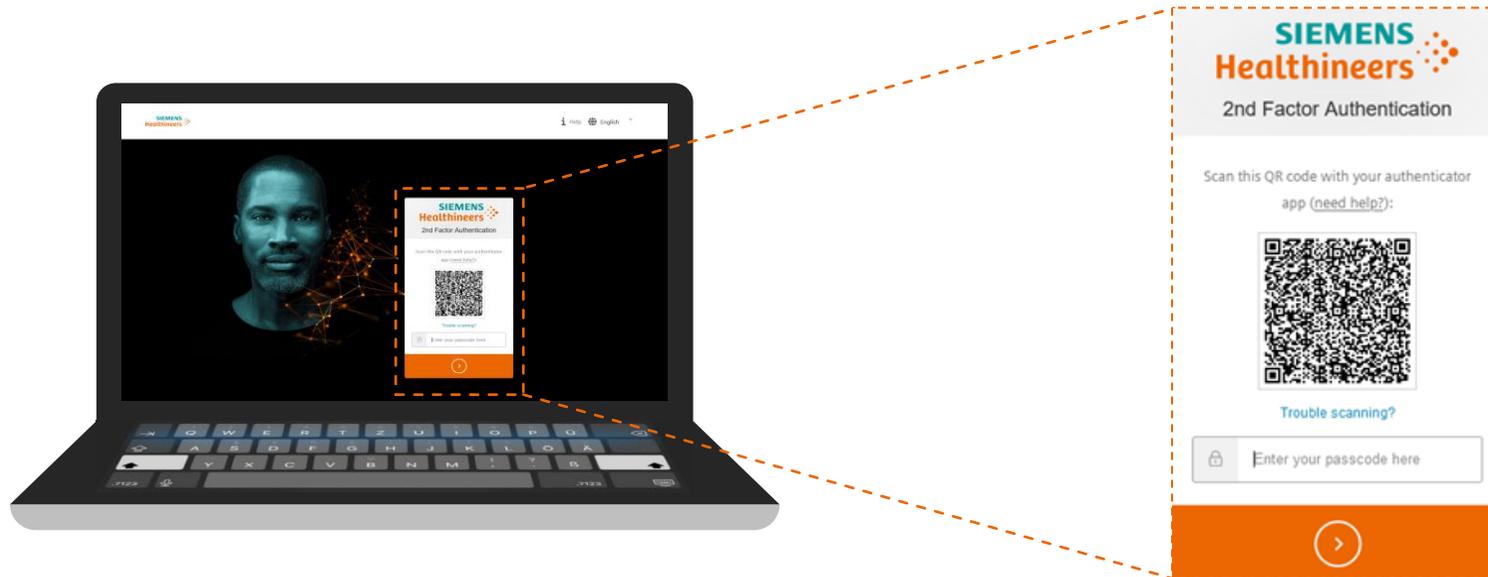

Method: Scan code with mobile device (preferred method)

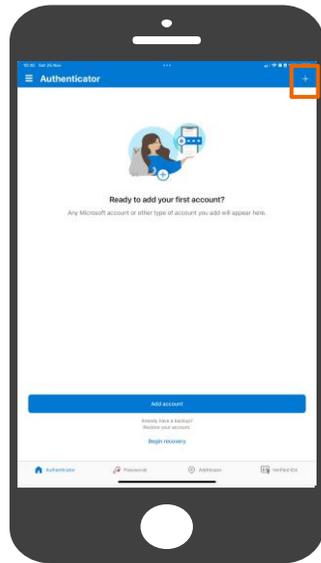

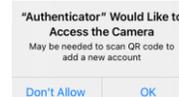
The authenticator app now is ready to scan the QR code from the browser screen.

We need camera access with this process, so you must approve by allowing in this dialog.



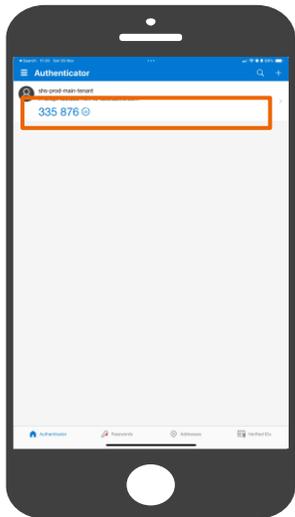
Press **“Or enter code manually”** if you are unable to scan the code from the browser yet.

With the authenticator app on your mobile device scan the QR code from the browser.

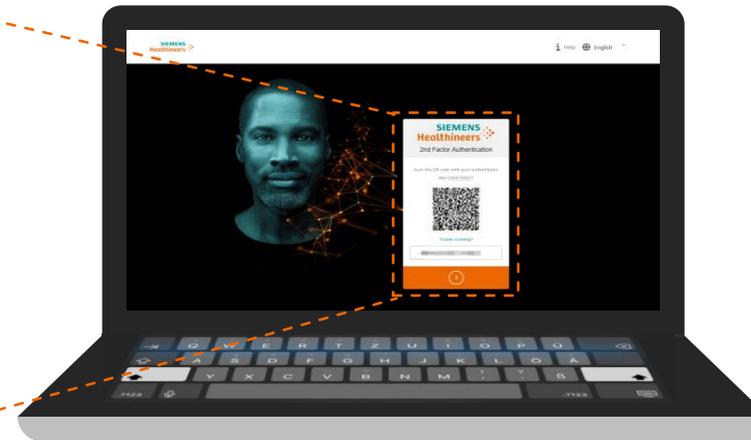
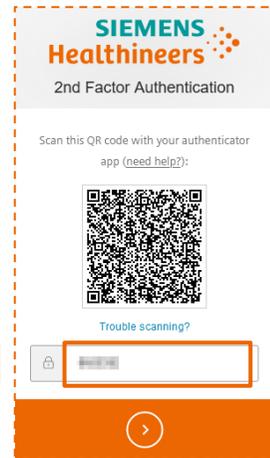


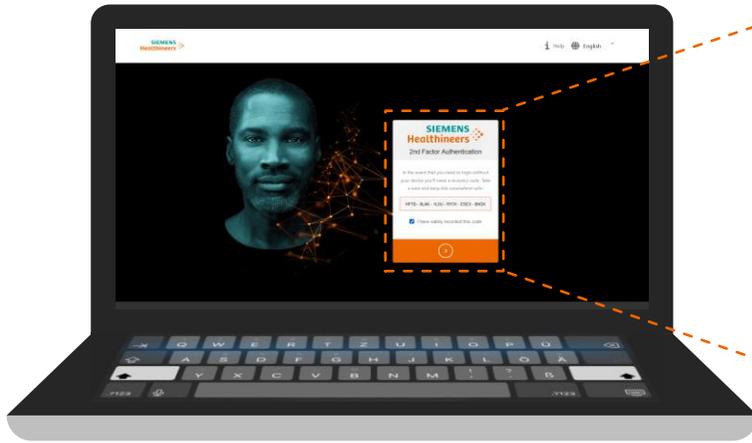

Method: Copy code to mobile device (alternative method)

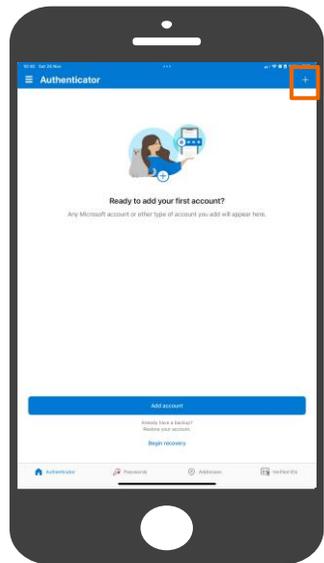
If MFA is not enrolled for your account yet, you will see this QR code in your browser to start the MFA enrollment.

This tutorial describes step-by-step how to **copy a code from your browser to your authenticator app** of your choice to bind your MFA profile in the authenticator app on your mobile device with your Healthineers-ID account for subsequent use as secure MFA login.

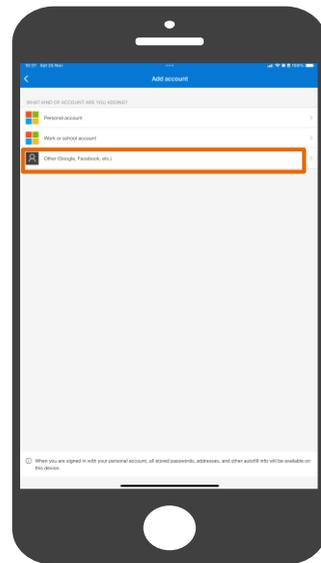


Open the authenticator app of your choice.

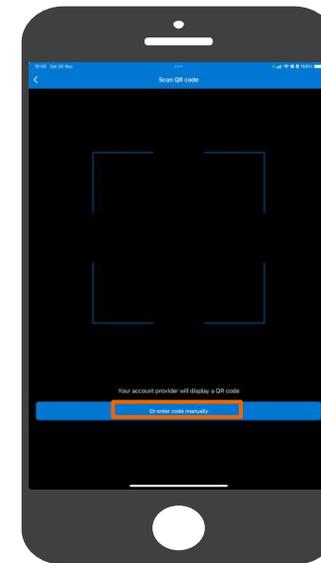

Select the 3rd option **“Other (Google, Facebook, etc.)”** to continue.



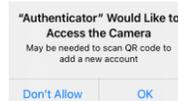
Press **“Or enter code manually”** if you are unable to scan the code from the browser yet.

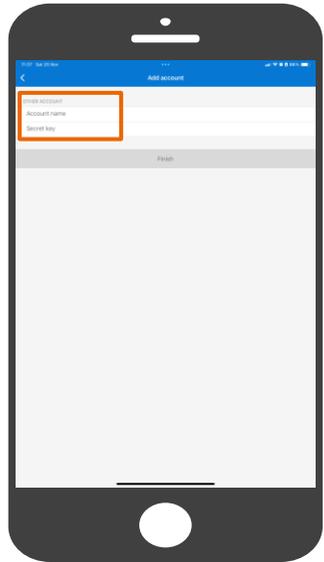
You may see a dialog like this:

You can still decide to scan the code instead of entering it manually.

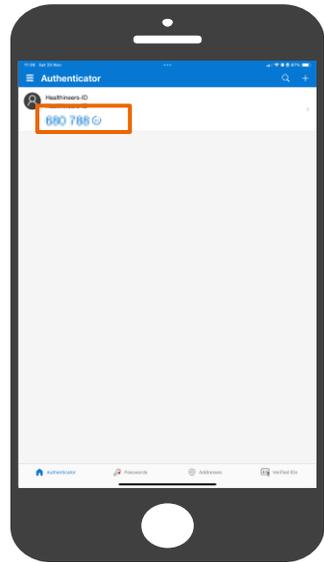
For the “**Account name**” we recommend something speaking like “SHS” or even added the registered email address like “SHS – my@email.com”

In the field “**Secret key**” enter the code you have copied in the last step, that you have performed before starting the authenticator app steps on your mobile device.

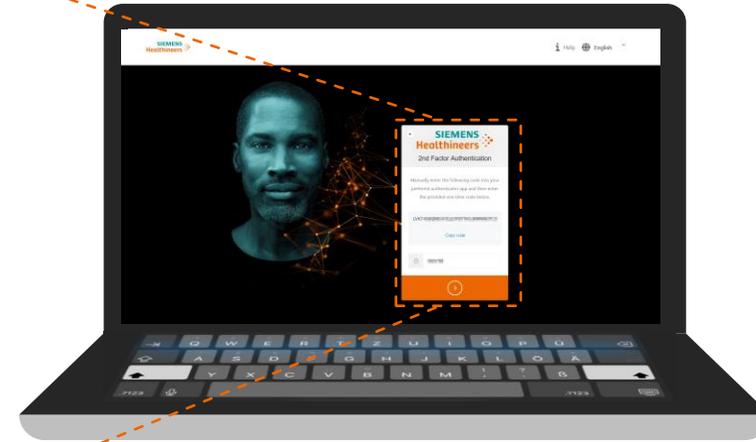
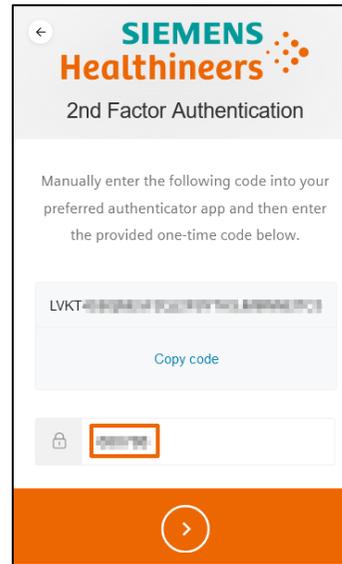
This is the browser screen where you got the code from:



Click “Finish” once the “Account name” and “Secret key” are entered.



Now enter the 6-digit code displayed in your authenticator app to the browse field "Enter your passcode here".

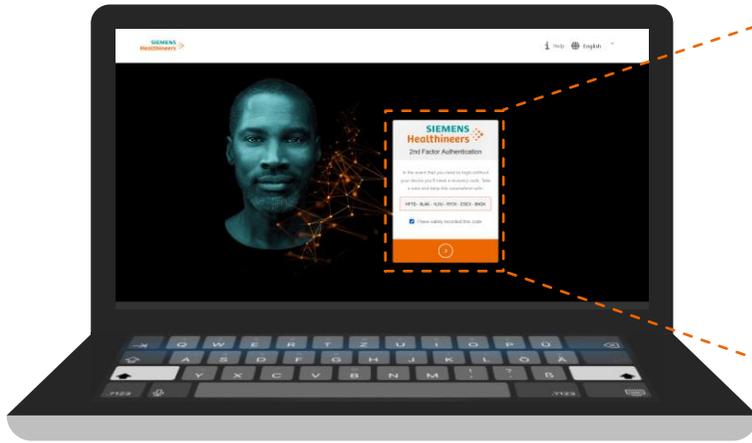


In this step your MFA profile in the authenticator app of your mobile device is bound to your Healthineers-ID account.

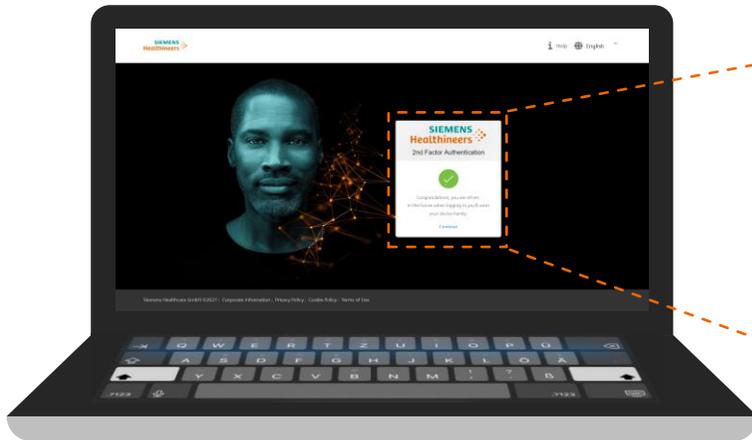
