
What you need to know for your SPECT exam.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN AT MY APPOINTMENT?

You'll be asked to change into a gown, and then you will lie down on a patient table. The table will recline and the camera will move into position and rotate around your chest. Once you are in the correct position, your technologist may ask you to remain still. You'll hear a low whirring sound during the exam.

YOUR SPECT EXAM CHECKLIST

- Remove all metal objects, such as a belt or jewelry.
- Bring images from previous examination (including X-rays) with you.
- Let your physician know if you have had previous allergic reactions.

WHAT IS A SPECT EXAM?

SPECT scans use invisible beams of ionizing radiation that pass through the body to create an image.
